



# Samos Greece Earthquake and Tsunami Appeal

On 30<sup>th</sup> October 2020, Samos, a Greek island in the Aegean Sea, was hit with an earthquake measuring 7.0 on the Richter Scale, followed by a tsunami. Over the following days the island experienced a series of earthquakes measuring up to 6.8 which resulted in the island rising by 25 cm.

Seismologists are expecting another major quake in the near future.

Many houses have collapsed. People are homeless and sleeping in cars.

They urgently need your help to rebuild their homes.

The purpose of the Samos earthquake appeal is to fundraise and canvas financial support to assist the homeless people of Samos to rebuild their lives.
